We are very pleased to see that many researchers from Asian countries, Australia, Mexico, Brazil and International Organizations as well as from various institutions of Japan are gathered here to exchange information on these fields.

I sincerely hope that the symposium will be successful and contribute to the promotion of research for the improvement of the utilization of feed resources to enhance ruminant production in the tropics and sub-tropics.

Again I would like to extend my heartful welcome to all the distinguished guests and participants.
