Dr. Seth Meyer

Dr. Meyer has been the Chief Economist of the U.S. Department of Agriculture (USDA) since January 2021, overseeing the World Agricultural Supply and Demand Estimates (WASDE), a monthly publication. Previously, he was an economist at the Food and Agriculture Organization (FAO) and a research professor at the Food and Agricultural Policy Research Institute at the University of Missouri, specializing in agricultural policy analysis. He obtained his bachelor's and master's degrees from Iowa State University and his Ph.D. in Agricultural Economics from the University of Missouri-Columbia.



Dr. Keith Wiebe

Dr. Wiebe has been at the International Food Policy Research Institute (IFPRI) since 2013, currently leading the Foresight and Policy Modeling Unit, which focuses on climate change, natural resource management, agricultural productivity, and food security. Before IFPRI, he was Deputy Director at FAO's Agricultural Development Economics Division and edited the State of Food and Agriculture report. He obtained his bachelor's degree from Carleton University and his master's and Ph.D. in Agricultural Economics from the University of Wisconsin-Madison.
